- 1. Just like all the kids, some dogs always go <u>to</u> school.
- 2. George and James are the school dogs <mark>of</mark> the TMG.
- When the two arrive <u>at</u> school <u>at</u> five past seven <u>in</u> the morning, they have already been up <u>for</u> more than two hours.
- Before school <u>in</u> the morning, George and James go for a walk <u>at</u> five fifteen.
- 5. <u>After</u> the walk, they have breakfast <u>in</u> kitchen.
- 6. <u>At</u> five to seven they get <u>into</u> the car to school.
- 7. <u>At</u> school, kids are waiting to open the door for them.
- 8. <u>Before</u> the first lesson, George and James walk <u>to</u> Mrs Anzt's room.
- 9. Sometimes they wait <u>in front of</u> the door because Mrs Anzt is not there yet.
- 10. Mrs Anzt has got some treats <u>in</u> a box.
- 11. George and James eat their treats within seconds
- 12. The dogs know that Mr Beck keeps his treats <u>in</u> a glass jar.
- 13. James tells Mr Beck about the treats by sitting next to him and putting his head on the desk.
- 14. The kids hide their treats <u>in</u> empty rolls of toilet paper.
- 15. George and James like going <u>to</u> school.
- 16. George and James think it's really cool <u>at</u> school.
